

House inspection checklist:

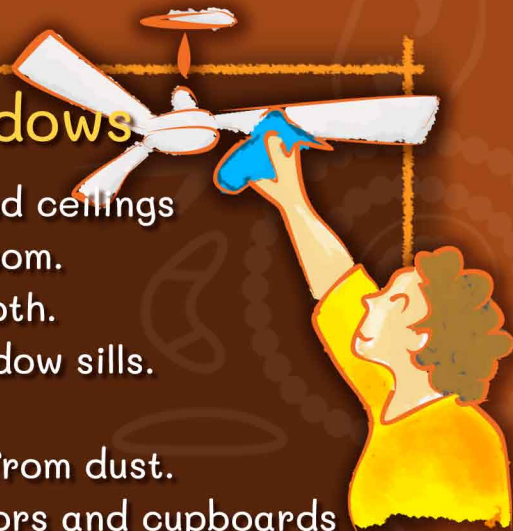
First of all, we'll need:

- dishwashing liquid
- 2 non-scratch scourers (for kitchen & bathroom)
- paper towel/ rags
- a broom/ a vacuum cleaner
- a mop & bucket



#1 Ceiling, fans and windows

- Clear the cobwebs on walls and ceilings using a vacuum cleaner/ a broom.
- Clean the fans with a damp cloth.
- Wipe down all louvers and window sills.
- Wash the aircon filter.
- Clean all surfaces and tables from dust.
- Wipe dirty marks off walls, doors and cupboards



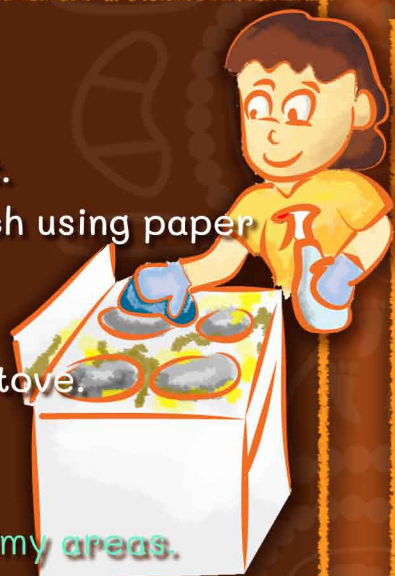
#4 Bedrooms

- Wipe all surfaces
- Tidy up the wardrobe
- Clean under the bed
- Remove rubbish and unwanted items



#2 Kitchen

- Wash all dishes and clean the sink.
- Wipe cupboards and kitchen bench using paper towels/old rags
- Clean the fridge and microwave.
- Clean the range hood, oven and stove.



Tips:

- Use dishwashing liquid to clean grimy areas.
- Wipe the stove after every use to prevent grease building up.

#5 Floors

- Empty all the rubbish bins.
- Vacuum and mop the floor.
- rinse and dry the mop after use.

Tips:

- Vacuum and mop the floor from the least dirty area: from the bedrooms, hall, shower area, living room and finally the kitchen. That way you won't accidentally bring grease and food scrap from the kitchen to your bedrooms.
- Turn the fans on to dry the floor faster.
- Keep kids and pets away when you mop until the floor is fully dry.
- Don't clean the floor by hosing it off, your tiles can pop up and break.



#3 Shower, toilet and laundry area

- Scrub the toilet with a toilet brush, wipe the toilet and toilet seat with toilet paper and flush it.
- Clean scum from bathtub and shower by scrubbing them with a non-scratch scourer with dishwashing liquid (keep the scourer for the shower room, don't use it in the kitchen) and rinse them off.
- Wipe other surfaces: the bathroom sink, vanity, mirror, etc.



#6 Outdoor areas

- Put all rubbish in the bin
- sweep the veranda
- mow the lawn
